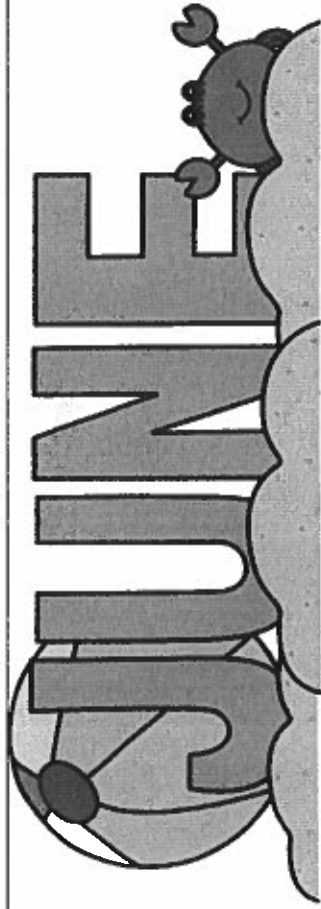
### KPRDSB STRATEGIC PLAN
