

You have been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19



You have any of the following symptoms

- · Fever
- · New or worse cough
- Shortness of breath
- · Difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Headaches
- Diarrhea
- Unexplained fatigue/ malaise/muscle aches
- · Chills
- Runny nose/nasal congestion without known cause
- Nausea/vomiting
- · Pink eye (conjunctivitis)
- · Difficulty walking
- Abdominal pain
- · Decrease or loss of sense of smell or taste

If you have any of these symptoms, do not come to school, and contact your medical provider or a COVID Assessment Centre for direction. The Ontario government also has an online screening tool specifically for schools: https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/
